

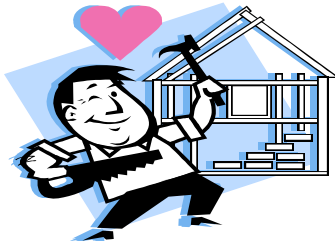


**PRESTWICK COMMUNITY BROADCAST EMAIL

With all our company (after all, everyone wants to come to the beach) and kids home from school, we have had a problem with parking on the streets.

You may or may not know the following:

PRESTWICK DECLARATION, COVENANTS, AND RESTRICTIONS

Article I. General Covenants

Section 5. Parking

Each Owner subject to these Covenants shall provide space off of streets or community roads for the parking in accordance with reasonable standards established by the Review Board.

Some of the streets in Prestwick are very narrow and a serious concern is that there is room for EMS to get through if necessary.

There is also no parking permitted on undeveloped lots.

Please be aware of your neighbors, can they get in and out of their driveway?

On another note, the new well project required in Prestwick Village is almost finished. We are hoping to have the pump installed on Tuesday, and then we can begin the clean up. Apparently, while installing the power for the pump, the phone line at the East gate was accidentally cut. We had to coordinate between Verizon (phone) and Carolina Time (gate) to get it repaired, and that took a few days. Because of the concern that EMS could not get in (no phone line to the Guardhouse) we left the gate open last weekend.
